

## Other Learning Experiences (OLE)

To broaden students' horizons, develop their multiple intelligences, make students all-rounded with development in ethics, intellect, physique, social skills and aesthetics, and instil positive values and attitudes, the school provides students with a wide range of other learning experiences. This gives students opportunities to learn outside the classroom through wider exposure.

By February, our students had participated in a large number of OLE activities. These included helping to clean a country park, the Yan Chai Charity Sale of Lotteries, flag selling, a visit to the homes of the elderly, an Other Learning Experiences Workshop held by the College of International Education of Hong Kong Baptist University, a blood donation day, a Disney's job experience workshop, the Tsuen-Tsing Caring Community Show, the Tsuen Wan District's flag-raising ceremony on National Day, visiting art exhibitions and the HKTDC's Education & Careers Expo.

From time to time, the school arranges and takes part in various cross-border study programmes to help students better understand our motherland and different cultures. They help enrich students' school life and improve their learning outcomes. Between January 18<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>, 40 students joined a Study Tour on Urban Planning and Environmental Conservation in Zhangjiajie, Changsha, and Zhuzhou of Hunan Province organized by the EDB.
