

Student Achievements in 2022 HKDSE

The results of the 2022 HKDSE were released on 20 July. 117 of our F.6 students sat for examinations of a total of 17 subjects (including Japanese) this year. They attained 516 Level 4 or above in all subjects (including Mathematics – M2) and 4 Grade A in Japanese. The best-performing students in different subjects are as follows:
