

Hong Kong Beverage Workshop

“Hong Kong-style Milk Tea Making Technique” was declared as one of the Intangible Cultural Heritages of Hong Kong in 2017. Milk tea has long been an indispensable drink and element in Hong Kong culture and the Hong Kong identity construction.

The “Hong Kong Beverage Workshop” was held by the History and Culture Society, in which the teacher-in-charge, Mr Yon Chun Tung, explained the origin and the spread of milk tea culture, and used maps to show students the interactions of different drinking cultures under the influence of the Age of Discovery and the Age of Imperialism.
