

Student achievements in the HKDSE 2016

The results of the HKDSE 2016 have been released on 13 July. 160 of our F.6 students sat for examinations of a total of 17 subjects this year. They have achieved 663 Level 4 or above in all subjects (including Mathematics – M1 & M2). 9 students obtained 30 marks or above in their best 5 subjects. 19 students obtained 5** in one or more subjects.
