- 3. Application Procedure

4. Documents Required

- a. The application form for S1 Admission from the school
- b. The application form for S1 Discretionary Place (DP) from the EDB (please fill in "Tsuen Wan Public Ho Chuen Yiu Memorial College" in the space provided for the "Name of School Applied For" in every copy and to be completed by the parent)
- c. Photocopies of school report cards (P.4 & P.5: both first and second term; P.6: only first term); Photocopies of certificates for awards, extra-curricular activities and community services stated in the application form (within the period from 1 September 2016 to 31 December 2018) The documents should be limited to 10 pieces of A4-sized paper (i.e. 20 pages, including photocopies of P4 to P6 school report cards)
- d. A stamped and addressed return envelope

^{**}Applicants need NOT submit recommendation letters from their primary schools.

^{**}Applicants should produce their ID cards for verification.

^{**}Application cannot be withdrawn after submission.

5. Selection Criteria

a. Academic performance

(according to the "Rank Order List" from the EDB) 60%

b. Interview 30%

c. Extra-curricular activities and community services 5%

d. Awards 5%

6. The Interview

a. All the student-applicants will be invited to the interview

b. Date: 16 March 2019

c. Duration: about 10 minutes for each student-applicant

d. Languages: English and Cantonese

e. Notice will be given in writing in early-March 2019

f. Based on the performance in the interview, academic performance (according to the "Rank Order List" from the EDB), extra-curricular activities and awards, the top 40 student-applicants will be given the offer of S1 admission.

7. Announcement of Results

The results of discretionary places allocation will be released via the central announcement on **9 July 2019**.

8. S1 Registration

Successful applicants are required to come to the school for S1 Registration on 11 July and 12 July 2019.

9. Pre-Secondary One Hong Kong Attainment Test 2019

Successful applicants are required to attend the test on 16 July 2019 (tentative).

10. Authentication of Documents

Parents are reminded that the information given in support of the application should be accurate and complete. Any misrepresentation will disqualify the application.

11. Handling of Documents

All application forms and supporting documents will only be used for the Secondary School Places Allocation (SSPA) System – Discretionary Places (DP), and will be destroyed if the application is unsuccessful.

B. Central Allocation (CA)

The Central Allocation (CA) procedure will proceed according to the Secondary School Places Allocation (SSPA) System of the EDB. The application period is from 11 April to 2 May in 2019.
