Assessments

- Format
- Coursework assessments only
- Creation (Written) + Presentation (Oral) for each assessment
- 1 group project and 1 individual work for each term
- Weighting
- Two assessments/ Term; 50% for each assessment
- Presentation (2-3 lessons)
- Written (1 lesson or homework)
- Measures to ensure fairness of the assessments
