

# Learning & Teaching Activities Updates

## 1. Resumption of Face-to-Face Classes

Face-to-face classes have been resumed since 26 February 2021 in accordance with the instructions from the Education Bureau. Students attend face-to-face classes for two days each week and online classes for the remaining three days. The arrangement is as follows:

In addition, supplementary online lessons are arranged for F.5 students so as to prepare them for the HKDSE.

## 2. Catering for Individual Differences

Enrichment and enhancement classes will commence from 19 April 2021 onward to help students develop their academic potential and improve their learning in Chinese, English and Mathematics.

## 3. The Use of iPads for Learning

To optimize mobile learning, the school has bought iPads for students in need with the use of Community Care Fund and loaned iPads to students who are not the target beneficiaries of the fund to make sure that every student can learn equally. In addition, there are planned class activities across F.1 curriculum to engage them in multi-media learning activities.

## 4. Lesson Observation

There are two modes of lesson observation to promote professionalism among teachers. On one hand, the principal organizes developmental lesson observation practice with the Chinese and English departments. On the other hand, there is peer lesson observation among teachers. The practice provides teachers with ample sharing opportunities.
