Using simplicity as the key design principle, I only designed the fonts. Through the strong contrast between black and white, the texts are highlighted with both distinct edges and smooth curves. In addition, the letter "Y" is enlarged because "Y" can stand for "Yiu" in "Ho Chuen Yiu", and represent "Years", which symbolizes the 45th anniversary of our school.	The whole design is inspired by the shape of fire, which means that when HCYers unite together, they are full of warmth and hope. The moon and stars symbolize the characteristics of teachers and students in HCY – caring and helpful. The number "4" is shown on the left while the number "5" on the right consists of a moon and flames, indicating the 45th anniversary of our school. The left side can also be the word "H", while the moon on the right side can represent "C", and the flame is "Y", which form HCY.	The shades of colours are used to distinguish "HCY" and "45", and a one-stroke drawing method is used to represent the long history of HCY.
