

F.5 Geography Fieldwork: Urban Renewal and Sustainability in Wan Chai

To complement the senior secondary Geography curriculum, the Geography Panel organised a Secondary Five field study on 17 March 2026 in collaboration with the Caritas Chan Chun Ha Outdoor Education Centre. The theme of the field study was “Urban Renewal and Sustainable Development in Wan Chai.”

The study area covered Wan Chai Market, Lee Tung Avenue and areas around the Hopewell Centre. Students conducted on-site observations and collected first-hand data to assess the sustainability of the redeveloped community. By applying the Five-Step Fieldwork Enquiry Process, students developed enquiry, analytical and evaluative skills.

To investigate economic sustainability, students carried out tally counts of shops and recorded price levels to examine the impact of redevelopment on local economic activities. For environmental sustainability, students used sound-level meters and air-quality monitoring devices to measure environmental conditions at different locations.

Through this field study, students integrated classroom knowledge with real-life experiences, critically evaluated urban redevelopment strategies, and reflected on the sustainability of planning decisions. The activity provided valuable experiential learning and enhanced their understanding of sustainable urban development.
